Did You Know?

In this warm weather we've noticed an increase in off-leash pets roaming the neighbourhoods. We returned a stray dog just a couple of weeks ago, twice he got away and fortunately he had a tag with his address on it. The point is, we need to make sure we take the proper measures to ensure a safe return of our accidentally, wayward pets!

1. Get your pet(s) micro chipped – it's fairly inexpensive and it's the first thing animal rescuers look for when trying to identify a stray.
2. Register your pet(s) with the City – if they catch your dog off-leash you'll get double the fine! But the advantage is that every dog registered with the City is sure to make it home safe.
3. Make sure they always wear a collar – that's tells people who may find your dog that it belongs to someone. Also you need it to carry your dog's proof of city licencing, rabies vaccinations, and it's a great place to put a personalized tag with his/her name and your phone number.
4. You must also remember to update your info if you move or change your phone number or all your effort taken for these precautions will be wasted.

All these things will ensure your pet's safe return. Nothing is more stressful than losing a loved one and not ever knowing what happened to them. Trust me, I know. We don't mean for our dog's to get out but it happens sometimes, we must be prepared for the unexpected!
